How we live in the Community - in the Church	Education for Living in the Christian Community	Catholic Church: Understand and appreciate the mystery and hierarchy of the Church - the Body of Christ - as one, holy, Catholic and apostolic.Ecumenism: Understand and participate in the call of the Church to be a sign of unity in the world through dialogue with other Christian churches.Catholic Principles and Relationships: Apply and practice Catholic principles as the vital foundation for interpersonal relationships and life choices.Vocation: Understand and undertake discipleship in Christ as a response in faith by living a specific call in the life of the Church.
