Instructions for Use:

- 3. Review social story and edit as needed to ensure that language, readability, illustrations and length are appropriate for your student(s).
- 4. Read the social story to your student(s) frequently.
 - Review story before and after drills.
 - Add copy of the social story to your "go bag" to read during drills as needed.
 - Send a copy of the story home with your student(s) and encourage their families to read it with them frequently.
