





(Forming Disciples for the New Evangelization)




About the Faith Knowledge Assessment:


About the Effective Learning Environments Observation Tool (ELEOT):





Parish Demographics and Sacrament Data *By Region*






2021-2022 ADW Mean Scaled Scores vs. National Mean Scaled Scores




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2021 - 2022 Scantron Performance Series, EOY Test Student Performance by Quartile








