# <u>2019 – 2020 ADW Elementary School Enrollment TADS Data Extraction – As of May 31, 2019</u>

As part of the strategy to ensure that all Archdiocesan elementary schools are on target to achieve specific enrollment forecasts for the 2019 - 2020 school year, on June 1, 2019, the Catholic Schools Office will extract each school's 2019 - 2020 school year enrollment data, by grade, through the TADS online enrollment interface. The significance of the May 2019 enrollment data extraction is to provide a status report that will enable schools to make strategic decisions that should influence their 2019 - 2020 enrollment results.
