What can your school do to prevent and respond to bullying?

First, be proactive by creating a positive school environment. You can model and encourage positivity by:

- Giving appreciative "shout-outs" during meetings or in social media
- Having "note fairies" or "random acts of kindness" campaigns
- Inviting community members to be greeters and welcomers
- Teaching and modeling conflict resolution skills (i.e. this <u>model from Nonviolent</u> <u>Communication</u>)
- Having all students/parents sign the ADW Technology and Internet Usage Agreement (available in <u>English</u> or <u>Spanish</u>)
- Networking with fellow principals for more ideas! (<u>Here</u> is what some schools are trying.)

Of course, not all bullying is preventable. When you hear of it, you can respond and notice bullying behaviors by:

- Using the staff and student videos and forms available to you free through Catholic Mutual
- Employing the help of surveillance programs like <u>Bark</u>, <u>Stop!t Solutions</u>, and Rethink.
- Using the ADW resources available on the Principal Portal, <u>Bully Prevention and Response</u>.

- HSPT registration opens on Monday, October 26 and will close on Friday, November 20.


