

#### "Go to Joseph..." Gen 41:55

On December 8, 2020, Pope Francis declared a special year dedicated in honor of St. Joseph to run until December 8 of this year. Our Holy Father, Francis, has always had a devotion to St. Joseph, but, in the light of Covid, he felt a particular desire to dedicate this year to St. Joseph in a special way.

When we read the Bible, we find very little mention of St. Joseph and none of his words were recorded in the Gospels. However, we recognize Joseph to be a man of quiet strength, with a great devotion to God and was obedient to his word. This quiet strength caused Pope Francis to note that many people had made hidden sacrifices during the crisis in order to protect others (just as St. Joseph did with the Holy Family).

"Each of us can discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support, and a guide in times of trouble," he wrote. "St. Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation." As we continue through this year of St. Joseph there will be opportunities to gain a Plenary Indulgence as well as reflect on the many titles given to St. Joseph (Terror of Demons is a personal fave!). In the Church, Wednesdays are days where St. Joseph is particularly venerated (just like Saturdays are for Mary and Fridays are for the Passion of the Lord) and this could be a great opportunity to recognize someone in your #ADWcommUNITY each week! Perhaps there is a student, faculty member or parent who, like St. Joseph, goes about quietly serving others. You could take the opportunity to recognize them as a model of St. Joseph each Wednesday.

This year is also a great time to teach a short prayer to St. Joseph and recite it on Wednesdays. See an example below. St. Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church, Pray for our #ADWcommUNITY!


