**RE:** House Bill 486- Child Sexual Abuse and Sexual Misconduct Prevention

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide guidance with regard to House Bill 486, *Child Sexual Abuse and Sexual Misconduct Prevention*, which will become Maryland law, effective July 1, 2019. The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) offers this guidance to assist public and nonpublic schools and contracting agencies with implementing the provisions of Md. Code, Educ. §6-113.2. The guidance does not include all of the statute's requirements, nor does it constitute legal advice. Schools and contracting agencies should consult with their legal counsel in addressing the requirements of the statute.

- Used to request the status of a Maryland Educator Certificate
- Employment History Review Form Child Sexual Abuse and Sexual Misconduct
  - o To be completed by current and former employers and the applicant for employment
- MD. Code, Educ. §6-113.2 Employer Report
  - Used to report an employer that has not responded to a request for information
- MD. Code, Educ. §6-113.2 Applicant Report
  - Used to report an applicant who may have provided false information or failed to disclose information
