

ARCHDIOCESE OF WASHINGTON 2022 – 2023 Fitzgerald Program

The Fitzgerald Program provides tuition assistance to students applying to or currently enrolled in a Catholic high school within the Archdiocese of Washington. Eligible students must demonstrate financial need and show promise as future leaders to our Church and society. This award honors students who have proven leadership characteristics that the Catholic Church and Catholic schools wish to foster.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To demonstrate financial need:

In order to be eligible for the 2022 - 2023 Fitzgerald Program, applicants must complete a *TADS Financial Aid & Assessment Form* online at <u>www.mytads.com</u> by <u>December 3, 2021</u>. Applications postmarked after this date will not be processed. Forms are also available from any Catholic high school in the archdiocese. **Please note**: Applicants are required to complete only <u>ONE</u> TADS Financial Aid & Assessment form to be eligible for both the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Program and the Fitzgerald Program.

Applicants <u>must</u> <u>email</u> the following materials to <u>tuitionassistanceprogram@adw.org</u> by <u>December 3, 2021</u>:

- a. Completed Fitzgerald Program application (form attached);
- b. **Two** leadership appraisals from school officials, such as the principal, assistant principal, teachers, counselors or librarian (form attached);
- c. Submit a 500 word essay about how your Catholic education has influenced your leadership and identity. If you are applying to a Catholic school for the first time, please explain how you envision that a Catholic education will influence your leadership and identity.
