

Working with Reports (for Administrators)

You can access the reports you need to use Performance Series results through the Reports tab:

Summary

Use the summary reports to gain a birds-eye view of your students' results. You can drill down through these reports to access more detailed information, or filter them to exclude or include specific data.

Gains

Use this report to view student growth between testing periods or within a specific date range.

Gains Analysis

Use this report to view actual student gains as well as target gains based on a comparison to a national norm group.

National Percentile Ranking (NPR)

Use this report in the Fall, Winter, and Spring for student-to-student comparison against a national group.

Performance Bands

Use this report for a color-coded look at how students' scores fall within performance bands defined for your site.

Understanding Report Statistics

You may see some or all of the following statistics on reports:

SS (Scaled Score)

An estimate of student ability using the Rasch single-parameter computer adaptive model

SEM (Standard Error of Measurement)

The extent to which the student's scaled score varies from his or her true score (in scaled score points)

USR (Unit Score Range)

An independent estimate of ability (in scaled score) based on responses for each unit within a subject

NPR (National Percentile Ranking)

The percentage of students that the selected student would be expected to score above in norm group comparison

Normal Curve Equivalent

A translation of the NPR into a standardized score that has a mean of 50 and is divided into 99 equal units.

Lexile Scale

A developmental scale for reading to match the student to appropriate materials.

Reading Rate

A measure of reading speed, calculated by counting the number of words in the passages the student read and dividing that number by the time it took the student to read those passages.

NA (Not Applicable)

An indication that either the student did not reach a level of questions that could measure these concepts or the unit is not adequately represented in the state or national standards for the student's grade level.

Performance Band Rating

Various reports show performance band ratings set up by your Location Controller to help you identify levels of proficiency and adjust instruction accordingly. These ratings apply color codes and labels to the scaled scores shown on several reports. Use the color codes and labels to quickly see a visual overview of Performance Series scores and grouping possibilities.


2. Click the **Reports** tab ...

4. Choose a testing period (Fall, Winter, Spring).

Viewing Performance Band Reports

1. Locate the Performance Band column.
2. Choose an initial filter row.
3. Click a subject in the Performance Band column next to the initial filter you chose.

The report appears.
