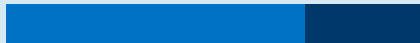

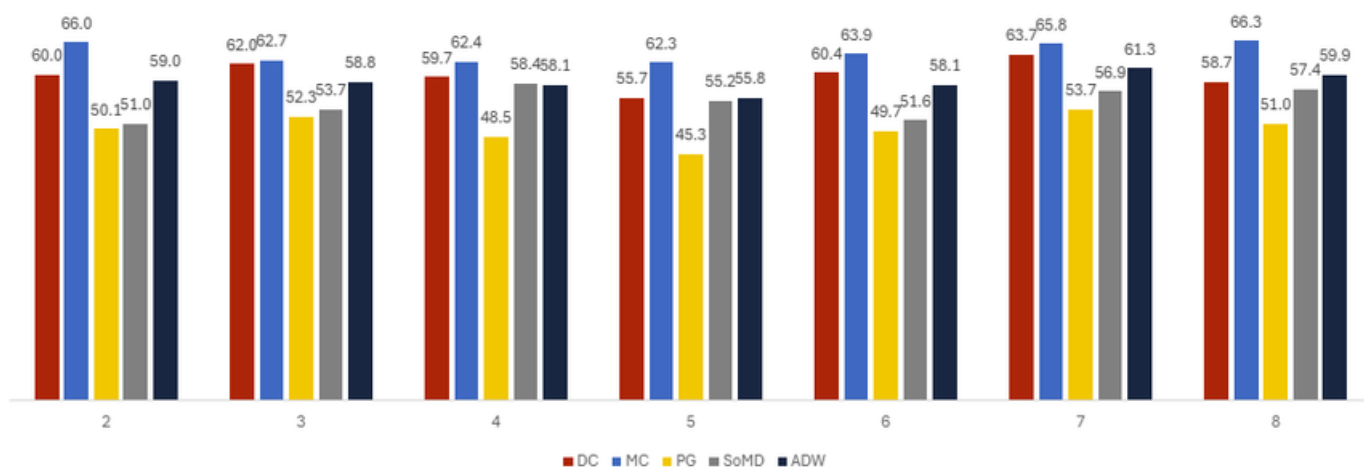

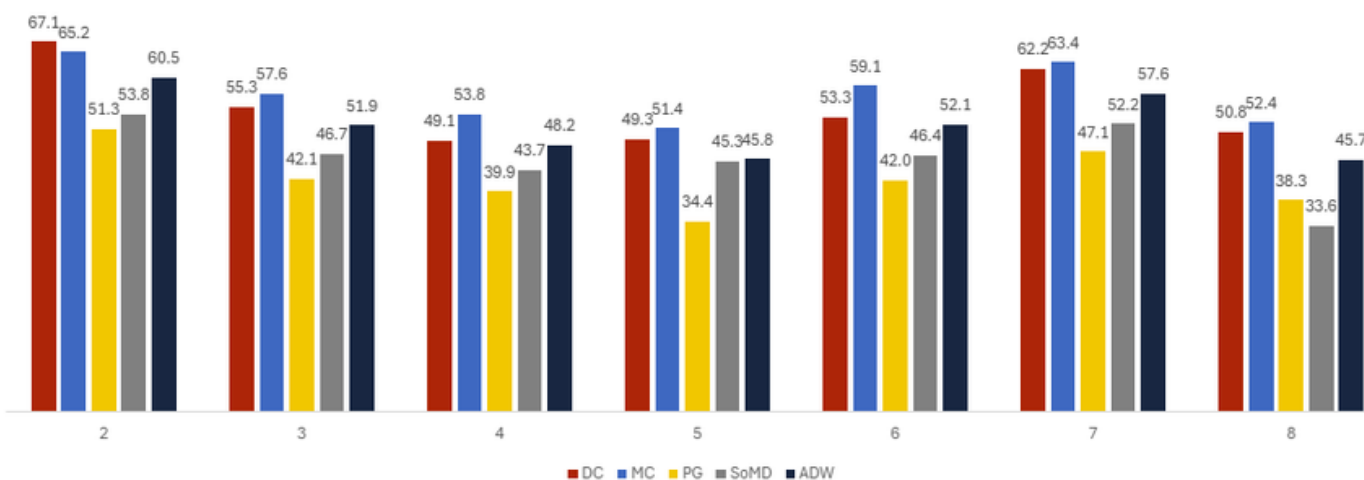


REGIONAL PERFORMANCE NWEA MAP NATIONAL PERCENTILE
